



School Uniform



- No facial piercing permitted
- **One pair of stud earrings permitted.** No other loop or drop earrings permitted;
- No excessive make-up / fake tan allowed. Make-up / fake tan should appear natural and should be minimal. False eyelashes, heavily drawn on eyebrows and facial piercings are unacceptable.

- Hair dyed or streaked with natural colours is permitted, unnatural colours such as green and pink etc. are not;
- Close cropped hair below **number 2** not permitted. Patterns shaved in to hair – not permitted;
- No hats permitted in school buildings - religious headgear excepted.

- **Only school polo and sweatshirt permitted:** Years 7 to 9 = Polo shirts must be gold/yellow with black piping and have a school crest; Years 10 to 11 = Polo shirts must be black with yellow/gold piping and have a school crest;
- Watch permitted, **no other visible jewellery.**

- **Acrylic nails are not suitable for school.** If worn, they should appear natural and be of a length or style that they DO NOT present a health and safety issue in PE, Science or Technology etc.
- Nail varnish is permitted but should also appear natural. Natural, 'nude' or clear varnish / lacquer is permitted. Bright colours (red, green, blue etc.) are not permitted.

- **Trousers** must be **smart, plain and black;**
- Jeans (with or without evidence of studs), jeans-style trousers, leggings, jeggings corduroy or other casual trousers not permitted;
- Belts must be plain black and hold trousers up – not for adornment.

- **Skirts** must be **smart, plain and black;** and of an appropriate length.
- Black or natural plain tights are permitted, patterned ones are not permitted;
- Shorts (with no visible logos with the exception of the school crest) of a sensible length permitted;

- **Shoes must be plain black;** No flip flops or shoes which may come off easily;
- Trainers permitted if plain black, branding is permitted but must be black. Branding of any other colour should be covered or removed;
- If socks are visible whilst standing (especially girls' sandals or shoes) must be black or white;
- Black boots are permitted (up to calf level). Heels no more than 4 cm.
