YSGOL FRIARS YEAR 11 SIXTH FORM INFORMATION FAIR July 1st 2019 from 1.35pm to 3.15pm

Dear parent/guardian

I am writing to inform you of an event we are holding at Ysgol Friars on Monday July 1st 2019 for those students wishing to enter Ysgol Friars 6th form in September 2019. Students can wear their own clothes for the event and it will be held in the school hall. The Fair is a student only occasion.

Present will be Mr David Healey (Deputy Headteacher), Mr Neil Worthington (Assistant Headteacher and Careers Coordinator), Heads of Faculty and Heads of Departments, Mrs Antoniazzi (Careers advisor) and myself (Deputy Head of Sixth Form). The aim of the Fair is to advise pupils on life as a Sixth form student in Ysgol Friars, including eligibility of EMA (educational maintenance allowance), the prefect system, as well as the next steps in the application process.

Your son/daughter will have the opportunity to discuss all the A level subjects available in Ysgol Friars with the teachers of the subjects. In particular, we hope it will help them make an informed decision if they have more than one choice in a particular column. Equally, Mr Healey will be able to discuss any external college courses and Mrs Antoniazzi will be able to discuss career options following A levels.

Following on from the Fair:

In August 2019, offer letters will be sent to all pupils who have applied to enter Ysgol Friars Sixth Form, to confirm that they have met the basic entry requirements for the Sixth Form following the publication of the WJEC GCSE qualifications and to confirm that they have a place in our 6th form.

Tuesday 3rd September 2019 is Induction Day for the new year 12 students from 9.30 am to 1.30am. Students meet with Dr Varty and myself in the hall for induction into the sixth form and to sign up for the AS level courses they intend studying. All students who have decided they wish to join Ysgol Friars Sixth Form are required to attend the induction day and if they have not yet completed an application form they can do so on the day. Students joining the Sixth Form from other schools should bring a copy of their GCSE and other KS4 examination results with them.

I hope you encourage your son/daughter to attend the Sixth Form Information Fair when discussing post GCSE options with your child
